## **Accomplishments**

112 species were identified, 55 birds, 9 mammals, 15 Amphibian, 26 Reptile, 2 fish above the water falls, 1 crustacean and 4 insects. Also, footprints in the sand look very much like Northern Quolls.

## **Comments**

The Napp Springs Creek system needs to be searched more up stream for pygmy crocodiles to see how many are left as we only found two, one adult and a juvenile in a 3km stretch of the creek during the ten days. Five Merten's water monitors were seen in this 3km section and another 8 were seen from below the falls to 7km downstream, 80% were adults. An abundance of monitor tracks were also seen along the 10km of the creek that was walk. It would be worth while researching why the Mertens seems to be doing so well considering the presence of cane toads.

Trail cameras need to be set to see if the Northern Quoll is present, as they are under risk of being wiped out by the cane toad and are usually one of the first specie to be impacted on with a 100% loss. Elliot traps should also be set for small mammals.

According to current literature the butterflies *Ypthima arctous and Mycalesis sirius* are not currently known to be distributed in the Napp Springs area.
