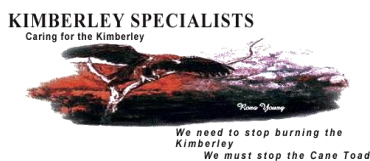

Conditions of Entry

1. Each competitor, (17 years and over only) may enter ONE work only. The entry must be the original work of the competitor and not exhibited in a previous Environmental Exhibition.
 2. Entries may be for sale. If sold there will be a commission of 30 % for handling expenses and a third of that fee will go towards the costs of a Biodiversity Survey in the region. (Artists are welcome to put more of the sale money towards that cause).
 3. THEME : ‘ THREATS to the KIMBERLEY ENVIRONMENT’
 4. THE SIZE OF THE WORK must not exceed ...
Paintings / Drawings 100 x 100 cm or 10,000sq cm. (incl. any framing)
Sculpture ... no longer (higher) than 100 cm and wider than 50 x 50 cm and no heavier than 10 kilos.
Installationsame dimensions/weight as sculpture and must be assembled and able to be carried / moved without falling to pieces.
 5. ENTRIES must arrive at **Lovell Gallery**, via PO Box 1275, Kununurra 6743, or be delivered to the gallery at 144 Konkerberry Drive Kununurra no later than **Friday 12th March 2010**.
 6. Entries must be clearly marked on the back (bottom) with the name of artist and the Title of the work. An accompanying brief description / story / poem is acceptable but not compulsory.
 7. Competitors hereby consent to their work being reproduced for publicity connected with the *Caring for the Kimberley Environmental Forum and Exhibition*.
 8. The Judges’ decision is final and no correspondence shall be entered into. Judging will take place and Results will be announced, between 19 & 21st March 2010.
 9. Some works may be exhibited for a period of time after 21st March, at other venues around Kununurra, for the purpose of education about the risks to the Kimberley environment. These artists will be notified.
 10. All other works must be collected ...between **9am / 4pm between Tues 23rd and Sat 27th March 2010**, from **Lovell Gallery**, 144 Konkerberry Drive, Kununurra.
 11. RETURNS.... If works can not be personally collected, the artist should arrange for a courier/agent to collect. No returns will be made by either road or post, or expenses met by **Lovell Gallery or Kimberley Toad Busters** .  12. Any works not claimed by the 31st March 2010 will be deemed to be unwanted and will be disposed of by Lovell Gallery as they see fit.
 13. All care will be shown but no responsibility for damage or breakage will be taken by **Lovell Gallery or Kimberley Toad Busters**, or any persons working or volunteering at the forum / exhibition. The art works are not insured while in our care and it is suggested that if the piece is of considerable value, the artist arranges their own insurance.
