## Conditions of Entry

1. THEME : Environmental threats to the Kimberley.
  2. Power-point style presentation using 20 slides of photographs or pictures delivered within 6 minutes and 40 seconds to provide a powerful environmental message. Pecha Kucha is Japanese for the sound of conversation. Each slide will displayed for 20 seconds each allowing students to describe the importance of the slide. Presentation can be delivered by individual students or a team. Children are encouraged is talk about changes that they are seeing in their environment or worries they have for the future.
  3. Schools are encouraged to run in house competitions and nominate teams for the Caring for the Kimberley Environmental Forum. Children will be invited to deliver their presentation as part of the Forum for judging. For schools remote from Kununurra arrangements including video entries will be investigated. Please contact Kimberley Toad Busters regarding possible arrangements for schools remote from Kununurra.
